Open to all Bulgarian public school students from 6th to 12th grades, the BCWC is a fun essay contest that allows students to express themselves creatively...in English! With fun topics (such as "What does God do for fun?"), national prizes (including English camp scholarships), and no stress, what's holding you back? Save the dates:

School registration: 5 December 2012 – 8 February 2013

Each school must create a profile and establish a contact person—usually a teacher. (Teachers, **REGISTER YOUR SCHOOL AT THE ABOVE LINK**) Full lists of participants will be verified in February. During the registration period, various creative writing lessons and past topics will be available for download from the website.

Competition: 13 – 20 February 2013

Under the supervision of a teacher, students are given one hour to respond to a grade-specific topic. They may not use any dictionaries, textbooks, or other materials when writing. It's the ideas that matter, not the grammar!

Judging and Awards: March – April 2013

Essays are judged regionally, with the best progressing to the national level. Judges can be English teachers, specialists, and native speakers. Awards for each grade level will be announced in April, with the official ceremony taking place in Sofia.
